Dr. Wu studied medicine at the Peking University in Beijing, China from 1980 to 1986. She was a chief and attending physician at the Peking University Institute of Hematology from 1986 to 1996. From 1992 to 1993, Dr. Wu was a visiting fellow in the Laboratory of Virology Diagnostics at the Institute of Virology of the Chinese Academy of Preventing Medicine in Beijing, China. She was a research associate at the Hematology Branch of the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute of the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, USA from 1997 to 2000. In 2000, Dr. Wu became an associate professor at the Peking University Institute of Hematology. She was the director of the Department of Bone Marrow Transplantation of the Beijing Daopei Hospital from 2006 to 2012. Since March 2012, she has been the director of the Department of Bone Marrow Transplantation of Lu Daopei Hematology & Oncology Center, Yanda International Hospital, China

Dr. Wu is a member of the Chinese Society of Hematology, the American Society of Hematology, and the International Society of Hematology. She is the coordinator in mainland China of the Asia-Pacific Blood and Marrow Transplantation Group and the vice president of the Committee of Hematological Malignancies of Chinese Anti-Cancer Association. She has published over 50 articles in peer-reviewed journals and serves in the editorial boards of the Journal of Clinical Hematology and the Journal of Experimental Hematology.
