Target Audience – Hemato - pathologists, Medical / Paediatric and Radiation Oncologists and others interested in hematolymphoid neoplasms

It will be a one-day program with introductory talks followed by interesting case discussions on above theme. You may join us as a Speaker or as a Delegate.

1. For speakers: You should be presenting a well worked up case of Hematolymphoid Neoplasm (leukemia, lymphoma etc) with an interesting point. The case should fall in category of the newly defined entities “WHO 2016 Classification of Hematolymphoid Neoplasms – What is new”. It may be a nodal/extranodal tissue based diagnosis or else peripheral blood/BM and flow cytometry/molecular techniques based diagnosis. In addition, you may present data of such lesions or any similar study from your lab. Each speaker will be given 10 minutes which include 7 minutes for presentation followed by three minutes discussion. Please send diagnosis of your case (before October 30).
